

Good evening! We hope this email finds you well and filled with excitement for the start of the school year. As we prepare to start this new academic year, we are eager to raise the bar in terms of student conduct, learning, and focus. To ensure a successful start to the year, please take note of the following reminders and important information:

- School begins promptly at 8:40 am; therefore, we request that you use the Admin gate between the Fine Arts building to enter the campus. This gate will be the only entrance open in the mornings (please see the revised bell schedule attached).
- Anticipate heavy traffic during the opening days of school and make arrangements to leave earlier than usual. When dropping off students, please use the north church gate and drive along the perimeter of the parking lot. Exit at the guard shack. We ask that you only make right turns when exiting the school before and after school, as this will assist in maintaining a smooth traffic flow.
- Student drivers who require parking at our school are advised to purchase a parking pass from our student online webstore.
- For the safety of everyone, please refrain from using the Camino Seco bus bay for pick up or drop off.
- Let us be considerate neighbors to the adjacent church by refraining from blocking the traffic lanes of their parking lot before and after school.
- School pictures and ID cards will be issued next week. Students can consult their English teachers for the exact date. As a standard safety measure, all students and staff will be required to wear their IDs during school hours. We will be providing further details on when this policy will be strictly enforced.
- We will also be distributing school devices next week. Once received, students will be expected to bring their school-issued laptops (fully charged) to school every day, along with the power cords and cases we have provided. These devices are increasingly essential to students' learning, and we require that everyone take good care of them as they represent a significant investment.
- Fall sports practices begin on Monday. If you plan on participating in a sport, kindly ensure you complete your ATS forms before being allowed to join.
- We strongly encourage all families to complete our District's Online Free & Reduced Meal Application at <http://mealapp.tusd1.org>. Additionally, families can set up an account to make online payments and add funds to their student's meal account via this website.
- Breakfast services will be available from 8:00-8:30 am daily.
- Please be aware that lunch lines may be longer and slower during the opening weeks of school. Rest assured, all students will be allowed to stay in line and consume their lunches

without being marked tardy if necessary, as long as they enter the line before the last 10 minutes of their lunch period. It is important to note that cutting in line or taking double lunches is strictly prohibited. Afterschool detention will be assigned to individuals who consistently engage in such behavior.
